



Entrance Tests for Top Law Colleges



The Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) is a vital national-level entrance exam in India, serving as the gateway to prestigious National Law Universities (NLUs) and other esteemed law schools. It evaluates candidates on various parameters, including English language, Legal Reasoning, Logical Reasoning, and Current Affairs. Success in CLAT opens avenues for comprehensive legal education, enabling students to explore diverse career opportunities within the legal field. The exam not only assesses academic aptitude but also identifies individuals with critical thinking and analytical skills, contributing to the shaping of the future legal professionals. CLAT stands as a decisive step for those aspiring to pursue a rewarding and impactful career in law.

Odds in your favour

With 26 NLUs participating in CLAT, a candidate has more than 3000 seats up for grabs in these prestigious National Law Universities. The better their rank in CLAT, the higher are their chances of getting into a top-ranked NLU of their choice. Efforts that a candidate puts into preparing for CLAT is also useful for appearing in other Exams like AILET, SLAT, LSAT, etc. that have similar and overlapping syllabus with slight variations in pattern.


Eligibility criteria for CLAT

There is no upper age limit and anyone who has passed 10+2 or an equivalent examination with a minimum of 45% or is appearing for 10+2 in April/May can write CLAT.

What skills will be tested?

School level skills in the following areas will be tested for CLAT 2025, with specific weightage for each section.

Subject areas with weightage (approximate number of questions)



The maximum marks for the 2-hour CLAT Exam is 120 (120 MCQs), with 0.25 negative marking per question.






NLU Delhi is one of the topmost law schools in the country with the added advantage of its location in the capital which gives access to the Supreme Court, Delhi High Court, Parliament, top law firms and much more to candidates spending 5 years in the NLU Delhi campus.

The AILET for BA LLB (Hons.) programme has three sections of 150 multiple choice questions for 150 marks in total. The duration of the examination is 120 minutes.

The three sections will be as presented in the chart.

Legal principles may be used in the logical reasoning section to test logical aptitude, but the examination will not require any kind of legal knowledge or technical understanding.

Negative marking: There will be 0.25 negative marking in AILET.









Symbiosis is one of the most prestigious private law colleges in India with campuses in Pune, Noida, Hyderabad and Nagpur. To get into one of these campuses one has to clear SLAT followed by a written ability test and a personal interview. It is a paper of 60 marks with 60 MCQs to be completed in 60 minutes

The syllabus and pattern for SLAT is as follows:

Candidates will be shortlisted for PI/WAT/ST-PI based on their entrance test marks.





LSAT is conducted twice a year, and its score is accepted by multiple private colleges including some of the prestigious ones like Jindal Global Law School, BITS Law School, Mumbai, UPES Dehradun, ICFAI, etc.

A total of 92 questions are to be completed in 2 hours 20 minutes. There is no negative marking for this exam.

There are many other state level entrance examinations that test candidates on the same 5 areas that candidates prepare for CLAT, thereby ensuring that their efforts are not wasted and they secure admission to a top college with the same preparation.

Candidates scores will be evaluated within a range of 420 to 480 which includes a score band and a percentile rank.



Maharashtra is the hub of some of the most reputed and prestigious law colleges with a very rich alumni base and legacy. Hundreds of prominent lawyers and judges have graduated from colleges like GLC Bombay, ILS Pune, etc.

To get into one of the 150 law colleges that accept MH CET score, one needs to clear the MH CET exam.

Frequently Asked Questions

When is the CLAT exam held?

CLAT is held annually, usually in the first week of December. However, the specific date may vary each year, and candidates are advised to check the official website for the most up-to-date information regarding the examination schedule.

Are the board marks or subject stream important for CLAT aspirants?

No, a candidate is eligible to appear for CLAT irrespective of his stream in class 11th and 12th. Board exam marks do not play any role in terms of weightage. However, a minimum of 45% is required for the student to be eligible to write the paper.

What is the exam pattern for CLAT?

The CLAT exam consists of multiple-choice questions (MCQs) covering subjects like English, General Knowledge and Current Affairs, Elementary Mathematics, Legal Aptitude, and Logical Reasoning. The undergraduate (UG) CLAT exam is for 2 hours. Negative marking of 0.25 is applicable for incorrect answers.

How many NLUs participate in CLAT?


Currently, there are 26 National Law Universities (NLUs) that participate in the CLAT consortium. These NLUs are spread across various states in India and offer undergraduate and postgraduate law programs. Successful CLAT candidates can secure admission to these prestigious institutions based on their merit ranks.

What opportunities does CLAT open for candidates?

Clearing CLAT provides candidates with the opportunity to pursue an Integrated Bachelor of Law (BA LLB, B.Com LLB, BBA LLB, etc.) degree at renowned NLUs. Graduates from these institutions often have promising career prospects in fields such as legal practice, corporate law, public policy, judiciary, academia, and more. CLAT is a crucial step for those aspiring to build a successful career in the legal domain.

Is my CLAT score accepted by non-NLUs for admission?

Yes, there are several private colleges that accept your CLAT score. Some of the colleges are Alliance School of Law, Amity University, Asian Law School, Azim Premji University, Geeta Institute of Law, Galgotias University, Nirma University and many others.
